EARLY YEARS FOUNDATION STAGE

All of our nurseries follow the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS). The EYFS sets standards for learning and development from birth to 5 years old.

We are a "learn through play" nursery. Our teams are trained to use learning through play as a means for developing children in all areas.

Prime areas

- Personal, Social & Emotional development
- Communication and language
- Physical Development

We strongly focus on the prime areas with our younger children aged under two. The prime areas create a foundation of all learning and development to prepare them to enter the specific areas of learning, explained below.

Specific areas

- Literacy
- Mathematics
- Understanding of the world
- Expressive arts & design





We take into consideration all of the children's interests and plan accordingly covering all the areas of learning. This is achieved through adult led activities and child initiated activities. We understand that children learn in different ways and so we provide suitable teaching and resources.

The environment is equipped according to the age bands of the children and we also encourage the children to explore the natural environment and resources.

The nursery is set out so that the children can use their independent skills to help themselves and help their peers. We ensure that we support the children appropriate to their age and stage capability. The nursery aims to provide children with the greatest knowledge and confidence so that they are well prepared when transitioning to primary school.





The nursery prides itself on providing children with a healthy balanced diet. Our menus are created following the early years' guidelines. All our meals are freshly cooked and we ensure we cater to all of the children's dietary needs.

Meal times do not only involve eating but also the social aspect of eating; learning to feed themselves, promoting good table manners and to be able to socialise with their peers around the table. The nursery encourages our Practitioners to join in on the children's mealtimes. This gives the Practitioners opportunities to promote good manners and role model positive social skills.

The nursery will actively work with you when your child is transitioning to solid foods. We use a weaning menu which will be altered according to the age and stage of your child. Parents are encouraged to introduce new foods at home first before we give it to them at nursery, to ensure they are not intolerant .

We provide three meals a day, snacks and water/milk. The menu can be found displayed in the nursery or can be requested.



7:30-8:30	Breakfast A selection of cereal, porridge and bread.
10:00	Morning snack Selection of fresh fruit
11:30	Lunch Hot meal followed by a healthy dessert
1:45	Afternoon snack Selection of fresh fruit / dry food
3:45	Afternoon tea Selection of light hot / cold meal

Water/Milk is available throughout the day.





OUTDOOR Play

All of our nurseries have a stimulating outdoor area, allowing the children to explore, investigate and take risks. All of our outdoor areas have a planting area so that children are able to plant, maintain and watch plants grow; this enables them to gain an understanding of the natural world around us.

Our outdoor areas have a variety of sections to support EYFS so that children can access all areas of learning outdoors.

Physical development is a prime area of education which supports the child in their learning and development; children need to be active as this is vital for their health and wellbeing. We provide a free-flow facility so that children can play outside when they desire in all weather conditions and of course we ensure the children are dressed appropriately.









OUR TEAM

All of our staff are fully DBS checked and have attained the appropriate qualifications.

We review our staff on a regular basis. We strive to train our staff thoroughly in their induction period and throughout their time with us, so that they are able to promote our ethos confidently and provide the highest quality of care.

We have an open door policy so that all staff can speak openly to their manager about their needs, ideas or any assistance required. This approach transcends to ensure happy staff, which in turn reflects in their teaching, resulting in happy children at Little Raccoons.

Key Person

At Little Raccoons Day Nursery we run a key person system so that when your child joins us they will be allocated their key person. They will be introduced to you and your child on their first settle session.

The aim of your child's key person is to build a special relationship with your child and to understand their individual needs alongside the EYFS framework. The key person will be responsible for tracking your child's learning development and to ensure that their activities are planned effectively.

Your child's key person will be available for you to speak to and if they are away, there is a secondary key person.
